Presiding Commissioner Mark Maples asked Kristi Stephens, Treasurer to address the sales tax issue. Kristi Stephens stated that the County is allowed 2% Sales Tax: Capital improvement, General Use and Law Enforcement all get a ½ of a percent; 911 gets 1/4; (none of the 911 sales tax counts for the County revenue.) County wide we have 1.75%, which leaves the County 1/4 of a percent left. After taking time to read the resolution from Sheriff Doug Rader, requesting an 1/8 of a percent sales tax for the law enforcement. Presiding Commissioner Mark Maples, Southern Commissioner Hank Smythe and Northern Commissioner Wayne Blades stated, they would not be in favor at this time, due to the fact it would just leave 1/8 of a percent sales tax for the County. Matter to deny the Sheriffs Resolution for the 1/8 of a percent sales tax, was brought to decision by a roll call vote: Smythe – yes; Maples – yes; Blades - yes. Matter carried, resolution denied.
