General Revenue Sales Tax receipts were up 12.16% for the month and up 17.40% for the year. Capital Improvement Sales Tax receipts were up 18.41% for the month and up 16.70% for the year. Law Enforcement Sales Tax receipts were up 18.41% for the month and up 16.46% for the year. The Local Option Use Tax is up \$40,918.0 from this time last year.
