Shall Nixa Public Schools borrow money in the amount of \$15,000,000 and issue bonds for the payment thereof, estimated to result in no increase to the District's debt service property tax levy, for the purpose of acquiring property for school purposes, constructing, improving, repairing, renovating, furnishing and equipping school facilities, including renovating and improving the High School stadium, constructing additional classrooms at Century Elementary School and replacing HVAC units and improving roofs at various District facilities?
