Witnesseth:

Whereas, a soil and water conservation district has been established in Stone County pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 248 RSMo, to-wit: the Stone County Soil and Water Conservation District, a body politic and corporate ("the District").

Whereas, Section 248.145 RSMo provides that

The county commission of any county or the governing body of any city, town or village in which a soil and water conservation district lies in whole or in part may cooperate with the supervisors of the district in carrying out the purposes of the district program, and in the event the county commission or governing body finds that the benefits accruing to the county or municipal area by reason of the program of the soil and water conservation district justify such action, the county commission or governing body may contribute money, services or the use of equipment to the district.

Whereas, the County Commission recognizes the significance and value of the District's programs within the County.

Whereas, the County has budgeted \$12,500.00 for the 2021 county budget year to contribute to the District to carry out its programs.

Now, therefore, the parties agree as follows:

1. The Commission shall approve and appropriate funding in an amount not to exceed \$12,500.00 for the District's operations during the Term of the Contract

2. During the term of this Contract, the District shall provide its services to the citizens of the County.
3. The Contract's term shall run for one year following the date of execution by the party last executing this Contract.
4. The District shall keep detailed and accurate records of its activities and expenditures and shall account to the County for all expenditures.
5. The District agrees to abide by all provisions of applicable government statutes and regulations in its operations.
6. The parties agree that each shall promote the public image and reputation of the other. Although each party shall be responsible for resolving its own complaints and grievances, each party shall notify the other, first verbally and then in writing, if such party is aware of any complaint or grievance about the other party's operations or conduct.
7. Neither party may assign its rights or duties under this Contract.
8. The County may terminate this Contract if, in the County Commission's sole discretion, sufficient reason for termination exists.
9. This Contract shall constitute the entire agreement between the parties. This Contract may not be altered, amended, modified, or supplemented, except in writing, and shall be delivered by the other party by hand, or by delivery to such party's regular business address by certified mail (return receipt requested).
10. The terms of this Contract shall not be affected by or interpreted according to any custom, industry or business practice, or course of dealing, whether between the parties, between or among either party and other persons or entities, or between or among other persons or entities.
11. The laws in effect in the State of Missouri, United States of America, shall govern this Contract on the day this Contract is executed by the party that last executes the Agreement.
12. All litigation regarding this Contract shall be brought in the Circuit Court of Stone County, Missouri.
13. In case this Contract, or any one or more of the provisions hereof, shall be held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable within any governmental jurisdiction or subdivision thereof, the Agreement or any such provision or provisions shall not as a consequence thereof be deemed to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any other governmental jurisdiction or subdivision thereof. In case any one or

more of the provisions contained in this Contract shall for any reason be held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any other respect, such invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision of this Contract, but this Contract shall be construed as if such invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had never been contained therein, and there shall be deemed substituted such other provision as shall most nearly accomplish the intent of the parties to the extent permitted by applicable law.

Whereas, Chapter 262 RSMo provides for an agricultural extension program to provide extension services to residents of the various counties throughout the state;

Whereas, Stone County has established a University of Missouri Extension Council for the County pursuant to Chapter 262 RSMo ("the County Council");

Whereas, pursuant to Section 262.590 RSMo, the County Council has the duty to arrange for and administer the County's share of the cost of extension services;

Whereas, Section 262.587 RSMo (Financial budget for extension programs-appropriations from counties) provides that the County shall provide certain minimum appropriations to the County Council;

Whereas, because the County Commission recognizes the significance and value of the County Council's programs and services within the County, the County is appropriating an amount that greatly exceeds the amount required by law;

Whereas, the County has budgeted \$57,027.00 for the 2021 county budget year to contribute to the County Council to carry out its programs;

Now, therefore, the parties agree as follows:

- The County shall pay to the County Council, to defray the cost of providing an agricultural extension program to provide extension services to residents of the County, shall appropriate and pay to the County Council the sum of \$57,027.00 during the 2021 calendar year.
- During the term of this Contract, the County Council shall provide services to the residents of the County as are described in Chapter 262 RSMo.
- This Contract's term shall run for one year following the date of execution by the party last executing this Contract.
- The Commission shall approve and appropriate funding in an amount not to exceed \$57,027.00 for the County Council's operations during the Term of the Contract. Said funds shall:

Witnesseth:

Whereas, §920.450 through 467 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri creates the Missouri Division of Tourism within the Missouri Department of Economic Development (The Division) to plan and conduct tourism information and advertising campaigns;

Whereas, §923.467 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri provides that, before the State's annual appropriations are sent, a statewide promotional marketing strategy be determined;

Whereas, the Division cooperates with local governments and not-for-profit corporations to plan and conduct regional tourism information and advertising campaigns;

Whereas, the County has for many years participated in regional tourism information and advertising campaigns with the Division, with and through the Chamber;

Whereas, the County has in its 2021 budget appropriated \$70,000.00 to be used in part of the cost to provide and distribute certain tourism information and conduct regional advertising campaigns, including the core and primary markets established through research; and the Chamber's annual membership in the Springfield Regional Economic Partnership (SREP), and \$15,000.00 for promotion of economic development within the County;

Whereas, the County wishes to agree with the Chamber to assist in and administer tourism information and advertising campaigns, and economic development, within the County;

Now, therefore, it is agreed as follows:

- The County has appropriated \$70,000.00 in funds in its 2021 calendar year budget, that the Chamber shall use as follows:
 - county advertising;
 - distribution expenses of the Chamber's publication, the Table Rock Vision Guide;
 - marketing consultant;
 - research expenses;
 - the Chamber's regional advertising, external/regional advertising, and internet marketing in the core region (approximately a 50-mile radius, focused on Benson, Springfield and Northwest Arkansas and designated market area);
 - website expenses.
- The County has appropriated \$15,000.00 in funds in its 2021 calendar year budget, that the Chamber shall use to promote economic development within the County.

The Chamber will maintain thorough documentation of the projects and the use of the money, and will provide copies of such documentation to the County on a timely basis. To track the results of its activities, the Chamber's print media and web site will display a toll-free telephone number and e-mail address, so that potential Stone County visitors can telephone or e-mail for more information. Toll-free telephones lines and a web site will be maintained at the Chamber's facility to receive such inquiries. The Chamber will provide the County the number of inquiries received. The Chamber will conduct and provide to the County survey research to ascertain the cost per inquiry (CPI) and the conversion rate (CR).
- The County and the Chamber will evaluate the results of the sales tax data.
- If the Chamber's cooperative partnership advertising project with the Missouri Division of Tourism Marketing Copy Fund Program is not approved by the Missouri Division of Tourism, or if the Chamber's application is withdrawn, the Chamber shall negotiate with the County to use the funds for one or more other marketing projects.

Standard Contract Provisions.

- The Chamber shall comply with all federal and Missouri statutes and regulations of the State of Missouri.
- The Chamber shall be annually audited according to generally accepted accounting principles for Not-for-Profit organizations. The Chamber shall furnish the County with a copy of each annual audit report to be due within thirty days after each such audit report is furnished to the Chamber.
- Neither party may assign any of its rights or duties under this Agreement without first obtaining the written permission of the other.
- This Agreement shall constitute the entire agreement between the parties. This Agreement may not be altered, amended, modified, or supplemented, except in writing signed by both parties. All notices given pursuant to this Agreement shall be in writing, and shall be delivered to the other party by hand, or by delivery to such party's regular business address.
- The terms of this Agreement shall not be affected by or interpreted according to any custom, industry or business practice or course of dealing, whether between the parties, between or among either party and other persons or entities, or between or among other persons or entities.
- The laws in effect in the State of Missouri, United States of America, shall govern this Agreement on the day this Agreement is executed by the party that last executes the Agreement.

Whereas, the Corporation is a Missouri not-for-profit corporation and has qualified under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code;

Whereas, the County has the inherent and incidental power to promote the health, safety, and welfare of the County's residents by providing a sensitive, child-friendly environment for forensic interviews, medical examinations and services offered to child abuse victims; to provide each family with connections to appropriate community resources; to provide a multidisciplinary team approach to each investigation;

Whereas, the County wishes to enter into a contract with the Corporation to provide services to the County;

Now, therefore, the parties agree as follows:

- During the term of this Contract, the Corporation shall provide a physical plant and personnel for conducting forensic interviews of alleged victims of child sexual abuse, physical abuse or children who have been witnesses to domestic violence.
- Interviews will be conducted by a trained forensic interviewer.
- Recordings and/or transcripts of the interviews may be used by the Stone County Sheriff's Department and the Stone County Prosecuting Attorney's Office. Both agencies are members of the multidisciplinary team that investigates child abuse.
- This Contract's term shall run for one year following the date of execution by the party last executing this Contract.

5. For providing such service, the County shall compensate the Corporation at a total lump-sum rate of \$15,000.00.

6. The Corporation shall comply with all statutes and regulations of the State of Missouri.

7. The parties agree that each shall promote the public image and reputation of the other. Although each party shall be responsible for resolving its own complaints and grievances, each party shall notify the other, first verbally and then in writing, if such party is aware of any complaint or grievance about the other party's operations or conduct.

8. For its activities during the term of this Contract, the Corporation shall report to the Commission by within thirty days after the termination of the Contract, of the use of said funds.

9. Neither party may assign any of its rights or duties under this Contract without first obtaining the written permission of the other.

10. This Contract shall constitute the entire agreement between the parties. This Contract may not be altered, amended, modified, or supplemented, except in writing signed by both parties. All notices given pursuant to this Contract shall be in writing, and shall be delivered to the other party by hand, or by delivery to such party's regular business address.

11. The laws in effect in the State of Missouri shall govern this Contract. All litigation regarding this Contract shall be brought in the Circuit Court of Stone County, Missouri.
