Approval of Commission Minutes

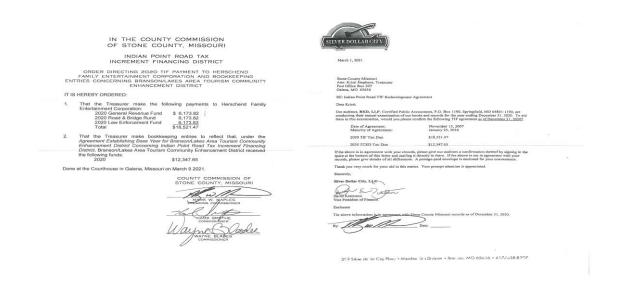

(15.26 acres) The Board voted 8 to 2 to recommend APROVAL of the Re-zoning. Presiding Commissioner Mark Maples allowed time for anyone to speak for or against the recommendation. No one came forward to speak for the recommendation, no-one came forward opposed.
