Open Bids – Wiring and intercom system for Jail

One ECC bid was for intercom Cabling Replacement for the amount of \$6,075.00 and the other ECC bid was for Intercom Cabling Shielded for the amount of \$12,825.00. Captain Frisbee will take the bids to review and bring his recommendation back at a later date.

Open Bids – X-Ray Machine Judicial Building

Billy Frisbie, Jail Captain, presented the Commission with four (4) bids for a new x-ray machine in the Judicial Building lobby. The four bids received were from
