Approval of Commission Minutes

Planning & Zoning Board Recommendations

RR-20-008 Jeffrey & Debra Paxton are requesting to rezone their property (3.5 acres) located at 9281 East State Hwy 86, Blue Eye, MO (parcel #17-1.0-12-000-000-039.001) from RR-1 to C-2 for a furniture Store. The Board voted unanimously 8 to 0 to recommend APPROVAL of the rezoning. Presiding Commissioner Mark Maples allowed time for anyone to speak for or opposed the recommendation. Debra Paxton came forward to speak for the recommendation, no-one came forward opposed. The matter to approve the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Board on the request to re-zone (parcel #17-1.0-12-000-000-039.001) from RR-1 to C-2 for a Furniture Store was brought to decision by a roll call vote: Smythe – yes; Maples – yes; Blades - yes.
