### **Planning & Zoning Recommendations:**

**RR-21-030** ST Properties, LLC is requesting to re-zone their property located West of Vacation Lane, Reeds Spring, MO (parcel #11-9.0-31-000-000-138.001) from a A-R to C-2 for a Resort. (6.22 acres)

The Board voted 7 to 4 to recommend APPROVAL of the Re-zoning. Presiding Commissioner Mark Maples allowed time for anyone to speak for or against the recommendation. James towery came to speak for the re-zoning. Several people came opposed. The matter to approve the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Board on the request for the Re-zoning (parcel #11-9.0-31-000-000-138.001) was brought to decision by a roll call vote: Smythe – no; Maples – no; Blades - no. Approval DENIED.

**RR-21-032** ABM Properties, LLC is requesting to re-zone their property located at 200 Dollar Street, Clever, MO (parcel #01-3.0-05-000-000-003.000) from a A-1 to C-2 for a campground. (10.43 acres)

The Board voted 7 to 4 to recommend DENIAL of the Re-zoning. Presiding Commissioner Mark Maples allowed time for anyone to speak for or against the recommendation. Anthony May and Nicole Baldwin came to speak for the re-zoning. Several people came opposed.
