Approval of Commission Minutes

The matter to approve the minutes for Stone County Commission meeting dated September 23, 2021 was brought to decision by a roll call vote: Smythe – yes; Maples – yes; Blades – yes. Minutes ordered approved.

The matter to put Prop P. with a 1/4 sales tax increase without subplanting on the April 2022 ballot was brought to decision by a roll call vote: Blades – yes; Smythe – yes; Maples – no. Proposition P will be put on the April 2022 ballot.
