Approval of Commission Minutes

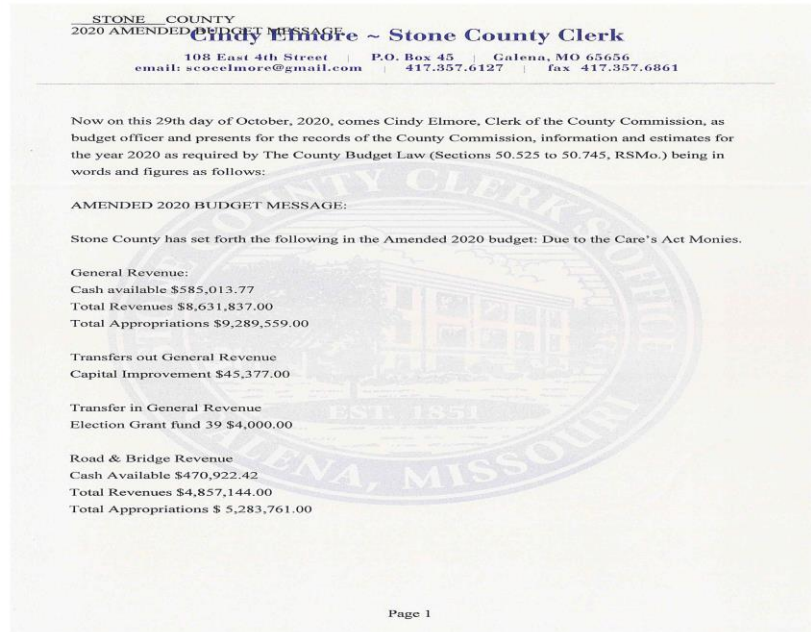
