## **Planning and Zoning Recommendation**

**RR-24-040** Bradley Sammons is requesting to re-zone his property located on Lot #1, Block #10 of the Cape Fair (original Town) Subdivision at 44 Shadrack Road, Cape Fair, MO (parcel #10-2.0-03-001-004-010.000) from R-1 to C-2 for a commercial appliance repair and hvac business. The Board voted 12 to 0 to recommend APPROVAL of the rezoning. Presiding Commissioner Mark Maples allowed time for anyone to speak for or against the recommendation. Deana Wolfe came before the Commission to speak on behalf of the rezoning. No one came opposed.
