Approval of Commission Minutes

The matter to approve the minutes for Stone County Commission meetings dated March 19, 2026, was brought to decision by a roll call vote: Wilson – yes; Campbell – yes; Blades – yes; Smythe – yes; Weathers - yes. Minutes approved.

Equipment Purchases

Brian Hackmeister, South Shop Foreman came before the Commission to discuss the purchase of a Barry Tractor Roller on a Sourcewell Contract bid #06122BA for the amount of \$137,768.00 plus a 84 month/3000 hours extended warranty for the amount of \$4,600.00 for a total of \$142,368.00. The matter to accept the bid from Barry Tractor for a Roller was brought to a decision by a roll call vote: Wilson – yes; Campbell – yes; Blades – yes; Smythe – yes; Weathers – yes. Purchase approved.

Brain Hackmeister, South Shop Foreman came before the Commission to discuss the purchase of a 2026 Western Star 47X Tandum Axel Dump truck on a MoDot bid, contract #60526CO0178 for the amount of \$197,265.00, plus a 7 year extended warranty for the amount of \$13,393.00 for a total of \$210,658.00. The matter to accept the bid from TAG Truck Center for a Tandum Axel Dump Truck was brought to a decision by a roll call vote: Wilson – yes; Campbell – yes; Blades – yes; Smythe – yes; Weathers – yes. Purchase approved.

Dewayne Marshall, Central Shop Foreman came before the Commission to discuss the purchase of a Kubota Skid Steer on a Sourcewell bid contract # 082923-KBA for the amount of \$90,107.76. The matter to accept the bid from Kubota Skid Steer was brought to a decision by a roll call vote: Wilson – yes; Campbell – yes; Blades – yes; Smythe -yes; Weathers – yes. purchase approved.

2026 Roads to be taken into County Maintenance System

- 400 feet of Ivy Way Rd. will be taken in by the Central Road and Bridge Shop.
- 0.5 of a mile of Curry Lane will be taken in by the Central Road and Bridge Shop.
- 0.5 of a mile of Hardin Hills will be taken in by the Central Road and Bridge Shop.

The matter to accept Ivy Way Rd., Curry Lane, and Hardin Hills to be taken into the County Maintenance System by the Central Road and Bridge Shop in 2026 was brought to a decision by a roll call vote: Wilson – yes; Campbell – yes; Blades – yes; Smythe – yes; Weathers – yes.

- 0.4 tenths of a mile of Campbell Point Ln. will be taken in by the South Road and Bridge Shop.
- 0.2 of a mile of Oak Creek Circle will be taken in by the South Road and Bridge Shop.
- 0.1 of a mile of Kaitlyn Rd. will be taken in by the South Road and Bridge Shop.
- 0.1 of a mile Rock Ridge Rd. will be taken in by the South Road and Bridge Shop.

The matter to accept Campbell Point Ln, Oak Creek Circle, Kaitlyn Rd., and Rock Ridge Rd to be taken into the County Maintenance System by the South Road and Bridge Shop in 2026 was brought to a decision by a roll call vote: Wilson – yes; Campbell – yes; Blades – yes; Smythe – yes; Weathers – yes.
