### POLICY - REPLACEMENT OF FENCES

The Highway Commission's policy for replacing fences, where landowners donate right-of-way, is:

1. The Highway Commission will pay for replacement materials and labor at the rate of \$1.50 for each foot of fence that must be replaced plus \$300.00 for each necessary H-brace corner post.
32. The Highway Commission may make exceptions for blind corners, blind intersections, complete relocation of roadways, or for other unusual circumstances. Such exceptions must be specifically approved by the Highway Commission.
