**Approve Minutes**

**Open bid for vibratory roller**

Southern Shop Foreman, Robert Hazen came before the Commission with two bids for a vibratory roller. The two bids received were from Bobcat for the amount of \$11,359.40 and Murphy Tractor for the amount of \$12,150.00. Robert Hazen recommendation is to go with Bobcat. The decision to accept Robert Hazen's recommendation for Bobcat in the amount of \$11,359.40 was brought to a roll call vote: Wilson – yes; Smythe – yes; Maples – yes; Blades-yes. Mattered carried.

**Aramark Uniform contract**

The Commissioners decided to terminate the contract with Aramark on July 15, 2022. Aramark supplies the uniforms for the Road and Bridge employees. The Commissioners made the decision to give each road and bridge employee \$350.00 per year for high visibility safety shirts and pants to full time employees. The Decision to give each full-time employee \$350.00 per year for their uniforms was brought to a roll call vote: Wilson – yes; Smythe – yes; Maples – yes; Blades-yes. Mattered carried.
