Discuss Equipment Purchases

Dewayne Marshall, North Shop Foreman came before the Commission to discuss the purchase of two (2) reach tree saw (boom saw) designed for trimming trees from Luby Equipment for the Central and North Road and Bridge Shops on a Sourcewell Contract bid #010925-FECON for the amount of \$53,800.00 with a three (3) year warranty.
