STONE COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES
PROPOSITION 911
Shall Stone County Emergency Services 911, impose an increase of one-fourth of one percent (1/4 of 1%) county wide sales tax for the purpose of providing funds for answering 911 calls, dispatching law enforcement personnel, fire department personnel, and EMS personnel. These funds will be applied toward purchasing Next Generation communication equipment, software, training, salaries, and benefits for 911 personnel. The approval of the proposition will authorize the levy and collection of a one-fourth of one percent (1/4 of 1%) sales tax in addition to the existing 1/4 of 1% sales taxes provided for by law on all retail sales made in the County which are subject to taxation, to begin collection as soon as is allowable under Missouri law?

<p>Shall Nixa Public Schools issue its general obligation bonds in the amount of \$47,000,000, estimated to result in no increase to the District's debt service property tax levy, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, improving, repairing, renovating, furnishing and equipping school facilities, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • safety and security improvements; • technology upgrades; • repairs and upgrades to HVAC units and roofs at various school facilities; • acquiring school buses and maintenance equipment; • constructing classroom additions at High Pointe Elementary School; • parking and traffic improvements at Espy Elementary School and John Thomas School of Discovery; and • renovating and constructing additions and improvements at Nixa Junior High School and Nixa High School? <p>If this question is approved, the District's debt service property tax levy is estimated to remain unchanged at \$1.0666 per \$100 dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.</p>

<p>Shall the Billings Fire Protection District issue its general obligation bonds in the amount of three million dollars (\$3,000,000) for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, improving, equipping, and maintaining fire stations, and purchasing or replacing emergency medical equipment, fire protection and fire-fighting apparatus and auxiliary equipment and vehicles to meet current safety standards, improve emergency services and carry out the objectives and purposes of the District, disposing of any replaced or outdated property, and refunding outstanding lease obligations of the District?</p> <p>The authorization of the bonds will authorize the levy and collection of an annual tax in addition to the other taxes provided for by law on all taxable tangible property in the District sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds as they fall due and to retire the same within twenty years from the date thereof.</p>
